**RE: Parole Release/Craig Munro and the Murder of Police
Constable Michael Sweet**

Mike McCormack, President of the Toronto Police Association, Charles Momy, President of the Canadian Police Association, Larry Molyneaux, President of the Police Association of Ontario and Karl Walsh, President of the Ontario Provincial Police Association will join with the widow of Police Constable Michael Sweet, and their three children, Nicole, Kimberly and Jennifer, who were 1, 4 and 6 years of age respectively when their 30 year old father was brutally murdered by Craig Munro on March 14, 1980, to announce specific initiatives they intend to take concerning needed changes to fix the Canadian Corrections/Parole system. This will be the first public appearance by Michael Sweet's three daughters since the murder of their father 30 years ago, as well as the first public appearance by Michael Sweet's widow, Karen Fraser, where the family will discuss Michael Sweet's murder, Craig Munro's attempts to gain his freedom and their frustration over Canada's Corrections/Parole system. The Canadian Police Community and the Sweet family will be asking all Canadians to join them in demanding changes that will bring transparency and accountability to Canada's Corrections/Parole system.
