TPA TO FILE FORMAL COMPLAINT

Your Association is taking immediate action in a matter of great concern to our members.

We are filing a formal complaint with the Ministry of the Attorney General over the outrageous decision by assistant crown attorney Jeanine E. LeRoy to drop charges laid in 2007 against assistant crown attorney Roger Shallow.

She did so without adequate explanation and she did so after refusing to meet to discuss the case which she was appointed to prosecute.

The fact that the charges were dropped, the way in which they were dropped on the day the trial was to start, and the unresponsiveness of this assistant crown to attempts to engage her on the issue in advance of the trial date are beyond unacceptable, they are a miscarriage of justice.

Shallow was arrested October 6, 2007 in the Entertainment District and charged with causing a disturbance and assault to resist arrest.

Your association plans further action, in addition to the complaint to the Attorney General, and we will update you further as soon as possible.
